- Allocating non-budgeted Grant Revenue and associated PPE triggers a domino effect across the entire Budget v Actuals Report (400 Grant Revenue matches 600.03 PPE)
- Services -\$7,000 Created by QB Online to adjust balance for deletion No Transaction has occurred
  - Explanation from our Accountant: This was related to a journal entry that was done in prior years (I think it was 2018) that affected customer CO PH & Env. When the customer was inactivated in October, QBO "fixed" the outstanding item of \$7,000 that had been booked in Accounts Receivable in 2018.

  - Checking Account Balance In order to maintain a healthy balance in the ColoTrust Account to take advantage of the current interest rates, monthly transfer will occur in the future. These will be allocated to Transfers from Reserves.
